ENOUGH IS ENOUGH! STRIKE AUTHORIZATION VOTE

Our Union will be conducting strike vote meetings starting this Wednesday, November 2. On October 28, Sharp management illegally declared impasse and unilaterally implemented selected parts of its so-called “last, best and final” contract offer, including the clinical ladder that we overwhelmingly oppose.

There are 19 opportunities to vote but we recommend you vote as soon as possible! You may attend any meeting that is most convenient for you. All RNs are encouraged to attend. Only members can vote. If you are not a member and want to vote, you may sign up to be a union member at the strike vote meeting.
