- Avid golfer, biker and mountain biker

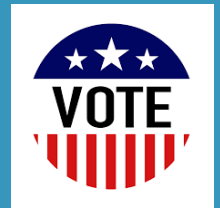

- Applications are due July 31, 2023, check your personal email

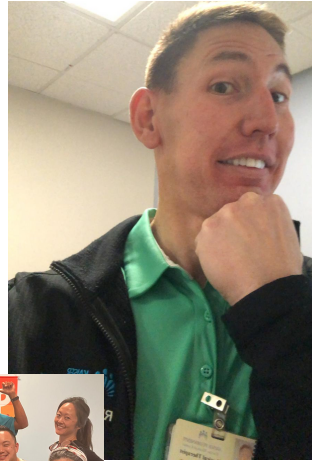

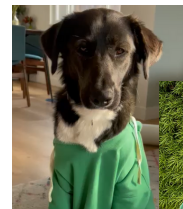
