

PETITION DELIVERED!

VAST MAJORITY OF UNHCEH MEMBERS SIGNED



On Wednesday, October 5, a delegation of UNHCEH members delivered our petition to the Maui Health executive team. Our UNHCEH Chair, Elizabeth Linares, Case Manager, delivered this message to Mike Rembis' office:

"Our members will not stand for some staff to get 1.5% increases. We deserve more for the services we provide and so does the community. Equally important, we need more to address the retention and recruitment issues. When we retain and recruit staff, our patients receive better care."

The petition carried more than 660 signatures—around 80% of our membership—showing management that we stand united to win a strong agreement.

Our next bargaining date is November 9th.

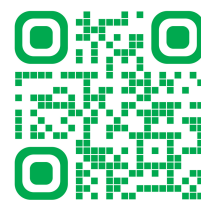
