Today in bargaining, our president Scott Byington, RN, delivered the 10-day notice that we're going on strike from Monday, October 9 through Friday, October 13, with an unconditional return to work on Saturday mornning day shift.

A huge turnout of members were there to witness the dramatic moment. RNs in the audience spontaneously spoke up about unsafe conditions in the hospital.

Before that, HR Director Barbara DeGuiseppe stormed out after our bargaining team caught management in a possible instance of bad faith bargaining. When management returned a counter proposal rejecting language we proposed, they simply cut out the paragraph without showing or telling us they rejected it.

For months, we've been pushing for safer patient care and dealing with management's unfair labor practices--like telling us to not wear our union shirts in our own hospital.
