

YOUR SAFETY AND WELL-BEING ARE OUR PRIORITY

We recognize there's a high level of concern among our people about the safety of their personal health and their families; and we want to respond to 2 questions that have been raised:

Will Kaiser Permanente provide me with personal protective equipment?

Yes, Kaiser Permanente will provide you with the appropriate PPE based on current, scientifically based guidelines according to your role and your clinical interaction with our patients.

If my role and interaction with our members/patients does not require I wear PPE, like a mask, may I bring in my own and wear at work?

Yes. In clinical areas where staff are caring for non-COVID-19 or persons under investigation and in nonclinical areas and areas where staff has patient and member-facing encounters, staff members may use masks brought from home, should they choose. As we build our capacity and are confident that we have sufficient masks for staff in clinical care, we will make additional masks available to staff working in these areas. If you bring your own mask, it must be properly maintained, functional, and clean.
