We're Standing Up For Our Patients

We voted and the results are in: 100% rejection of management's current offer. We are prepared to take action.

Chino Valley registered nurses are united for a contract that protects our patients and our profession.

At the bargaining table this week, we reached two tentative agreements.

- Letter of Agreement #4: Lactation Accommodations allows for a reasonable amount of break time for nursing mothers and allows RNs to pump with dignity.
- Article 11: Hours of Work, Overtime and Scheduling - This agreement contains multiple improvements to current working conditions.

Our next bargaining session is scheduled for August 7, when talks will resume.
