Paradise Valley RNs Stand Strong as Prime Attempts to Silence Our Voice



On February 26, 2020, we came together and voted to make Paradise Valley Hospital a better place to work and receive care. We won our election to form a union.

Registered Nurses know that by standing together and being united, we have more power and the opportunity to raise wages, improve working conditions, and improve hospital.

Instead of honoring our voices and sitting down to bargain a fair contract, the company filed an objection to our election results with the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB).

Over six months later, on August 26, 2020, the Board concluded a two-day hearing into the objection management filed.

What's Next?

Our Union and Prime will each submit legal briefs within a week to the NLRB. The Regional Director will make the final decision. We anticipate a ruling by Mid-October.

What Can We Do Now?

Stay strong, stand together, and continue talking with co-workers about the strength we have standing together in our union.
