## OUR TOP PRIORITY: KEEPING RNS AT PARKVIEW

Our UNAC/UHCP-PRNA bargaining team is committed to keeping registered nurses at Parkview for the sake of patients in our community. AHMC's economic proposal is disrespectful to our Parkview registered nurses and keeps us far below community standards and other AHMC hospitals.

Management's opening proposal does not keep new graduate RNs from leaving Parkview for better livelihoods, nor does it attract or keep much-needed experienced RNs here. Your PRNA bargaining team will continue to push for language that ensures meaningful improvements to protect safe patient care—including appropriate and safe staffing levels in addition to wages that reflect our worth.

On October 11, we did reach tentative agreement on Article 10 (seniority) and Article 25 (defining contract parameters).
