We delivered a slate of proposals to keep RNs, families, patients safe



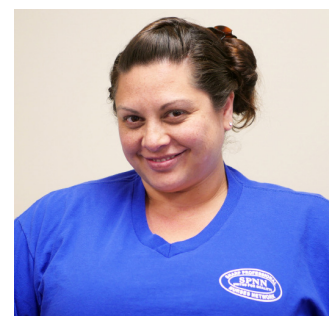

We introduced proposals that included parking and technology. We reached Tentative Agreements on two Articles, 2-Courtesy and 19-Medical Malpractice Insurance.

We are making our voices heard at the bargaining table. Investing in registered nurses is an investment in care. We know that good care leads to healthy families and communities.
