UNHCEH highlights from the past four weeks

Command Center implemented with COVID-19 guidelines recommended by UNAC/UHCP

- Collaboration with EOC to streamline employee COVID-19 screening
- Workflow established to assist employee health with better process for contract tracing
- Dedicated provider in the ER from 7am to 6pm for employee COVID-19 screening

Union participation in the daily COVID-19 command center meetings

Regular meetings with Mike Rembis to discuss issues and concerns, including improving communication between the union, staff, and administration; provide our solutions and recommendations – in which we have had success as evidenced by some of the highlights

- First meeting held on April 24th with frontline members from the ICU, Wailuku COVID-19 unit, Chapter Reps and UNAC/UHCP Staff; with a follow-up meeting held on May 6th
- A second group met on May 6th with members from the ICU, warm units - Hale South and Hale East, Pharmacy, Admitting/Financial Counseling, Chapter Reps and UNAC/UHCP Staff

Improved internal communications – the daily digest, biweekly townhalls which is accessible off campus, and a dedicated phone line and email to answer COVID-19 related questions

The EOC digest transparency on PPE inventory and orders

The Enhanced Benefit COVID-19 package, this benefit expires May 31st

- 80 hours of COVID-19 sick time
- Up to \$300 a week for childcare
- Short-term hotel housing

Additional 40 hours of PTO for employees who receive a negative test result but must remain off, this benefit expires May 31st

The Emergency Department staff has hospital issued scrubs

The Emergency Department staff in triage can always wear a N95 mask

Surgical caps available to those using hospital issued scrubs

Reusable hospital scrubs and bonnets became available on warm units (COVID-19/PUI)

Floating to COVID-19 units, only PACU/OR floating to backfill, no longer pulling staff from random units (*this work is ongoing, please keep us informed*)

Advocating to ensure floating is being logged and tracked

Advocating for consistent scheduling and minimal changes to schedule
